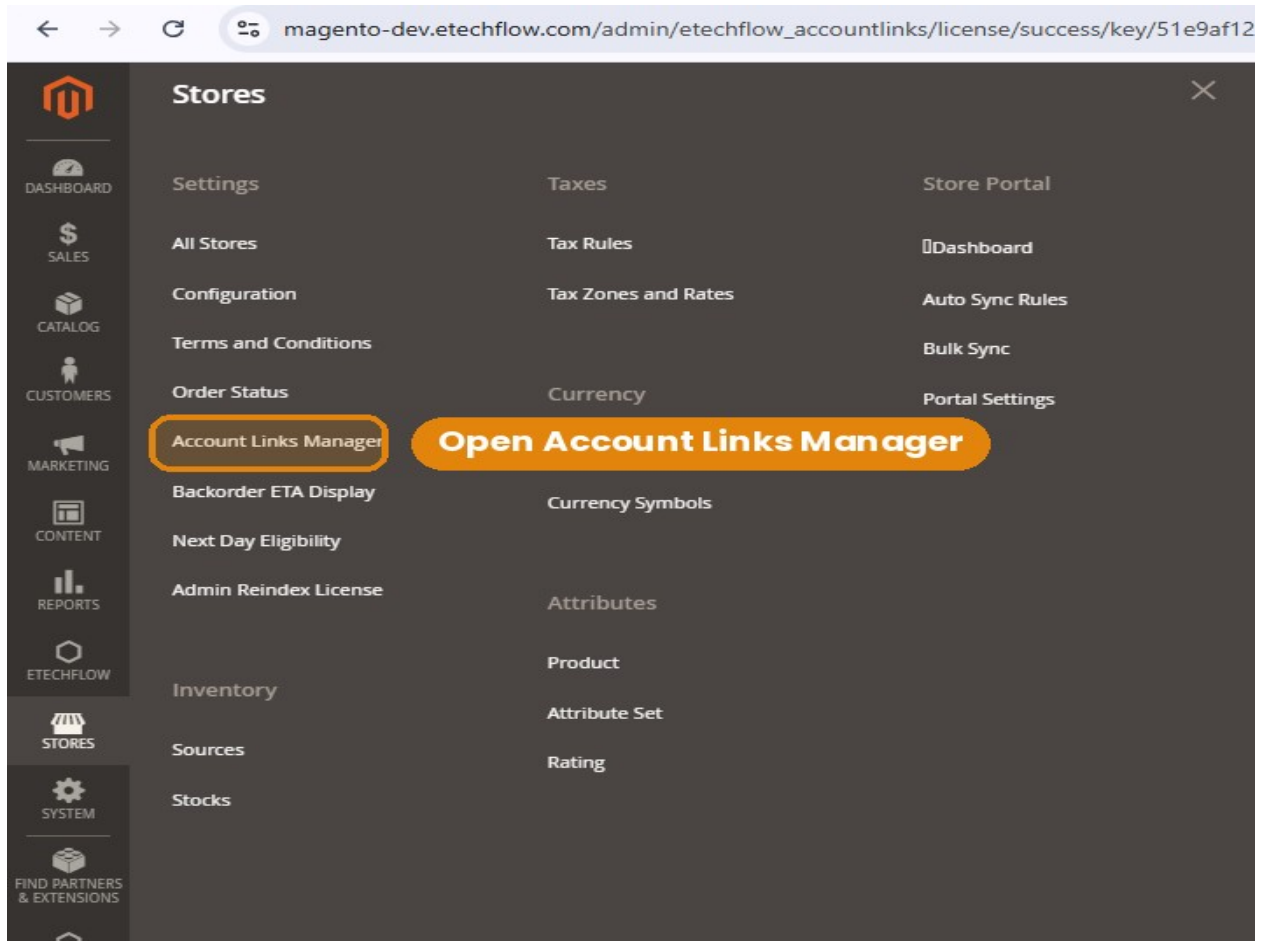

# 1. Introduction

Account Links Manager lets you control which navigation links appear in the customer "My Account" sidebar on the storefront. By default Magento shows every account link (Account Dashboard, My Orders, My Downloadable Products, My Wish List, Address Book, Account Information, Stored Payment Methods, My Product Reviews, Newsletter Subscriptions, and more). With this module you decide what stays and what disappears.

The module works in two modes. In "Hide selected links" mode the links you pick are removed from the sidebar and everything else remains. In "Show only selected links" mode only the links you pick are shown and everything else is removed. A master Enable Module switch turns the whole filter on or off, so you can disable it instantly and restore the default sidebar without losing your selections.

Everything is configured from the Magento admin under Stores > Account Links Manager. There is no separate admin feature menu — the module is entirely driven by these configuration fields and applies live to the storefront after you save.



## 2. Configuration

All settings live in the Magento admin under Stores > Configuration > ETECHFLOW > Account Links Manager (also labelled "Customer Dashboard Links Manager" in the ETECHFLOW group). Configure the module from the General Settings below.

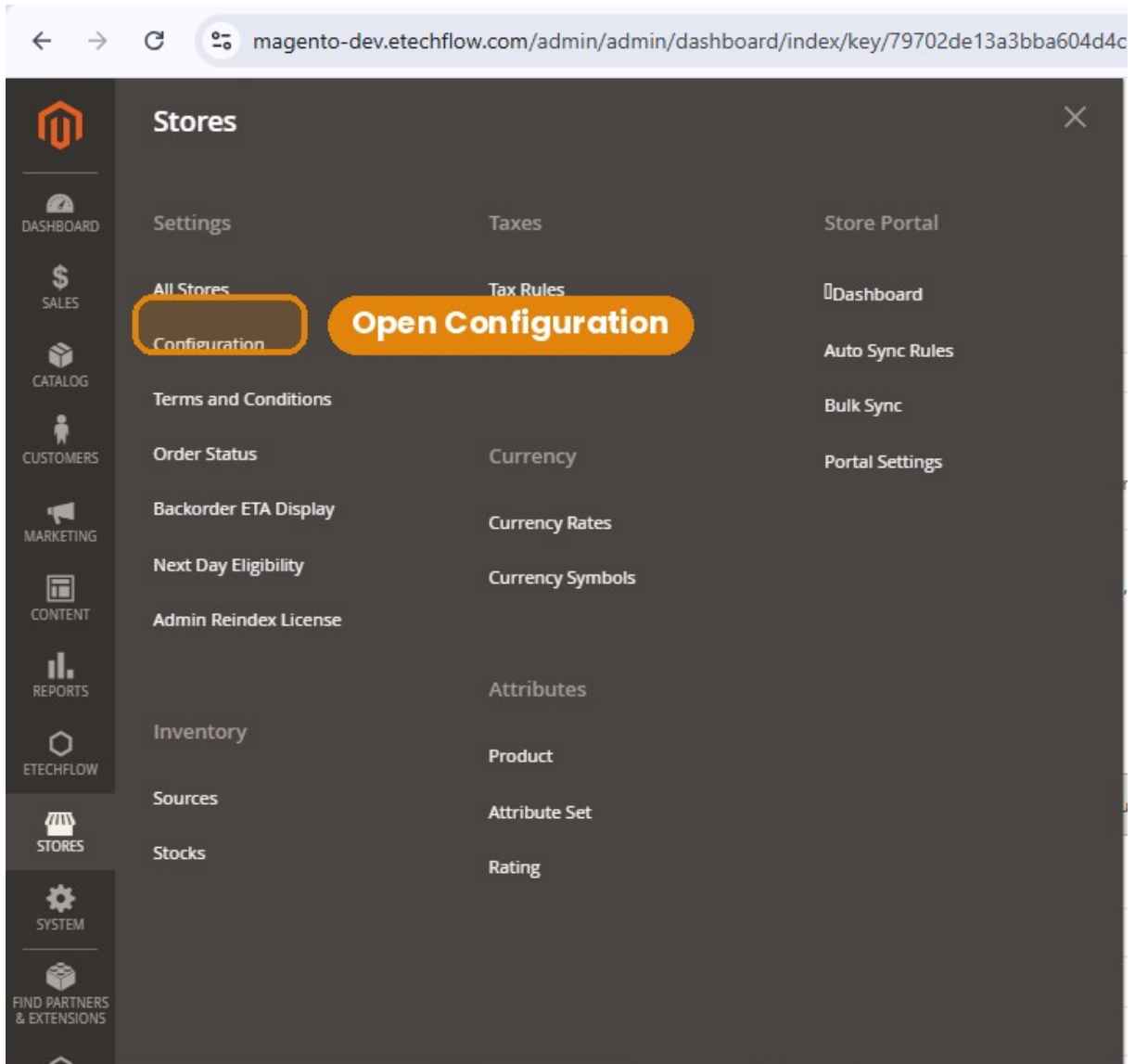
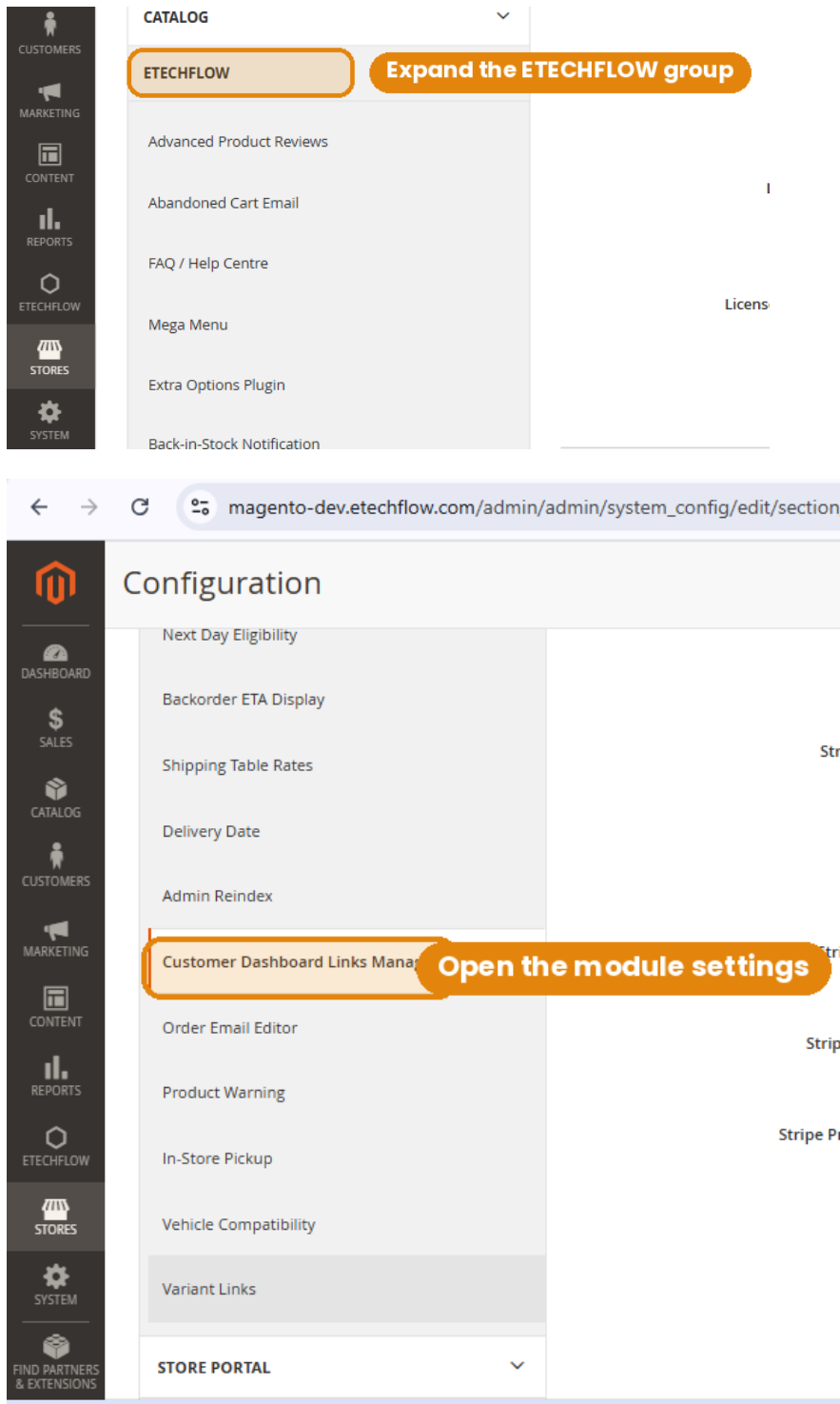


Figure 6 — Reaching the module: open the admin Stores menu, then Configuration, then the ETECHFLOW group.



## 2.1 General Settings

This section is where you actually choose how the My Account sidebar is filtered. It has three controls plus an optional advanced field.

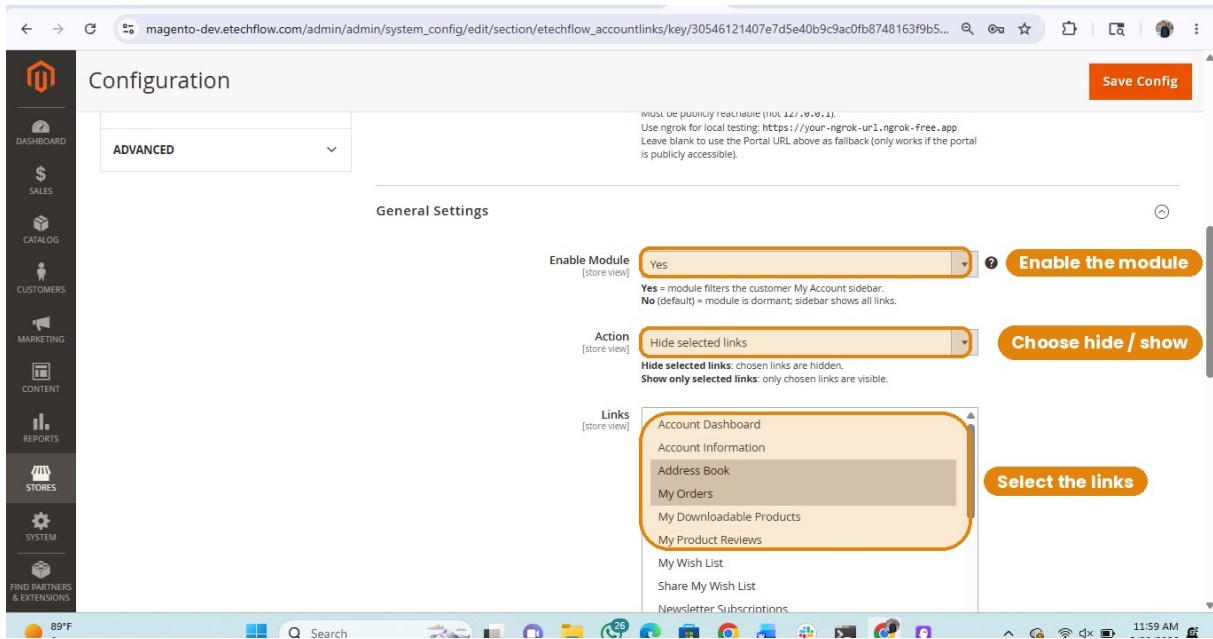


Figure 9 — General Settings: Enable Module set to Yes, Action set to "Hide selected links", and the Links multi-select with Address Book and My Orders highlighted for hiding.

**[ Enable Module ]** Set Yes to make the module filter the customer My Account sidebar. Set No (the default) to leave the module dormant so the sidebar shows all links.

**[ Action ]** Choose "Hide selected links" so the chosen links are hidden and the rest stay, or "Show only selected links" so only the chosen links are visible and the rest are removed.

**[ Links ]** The multi-select list of account links — Account Dashboard, Account Information, Address Book, My Orders, My Downloadable Products, My Product Reviews, My Wish List, Share My Wish List, Newsletter Subscriptions, Stored Payment Methods, and more. Ctrl/Cmd-click to select the links the Action applies to.

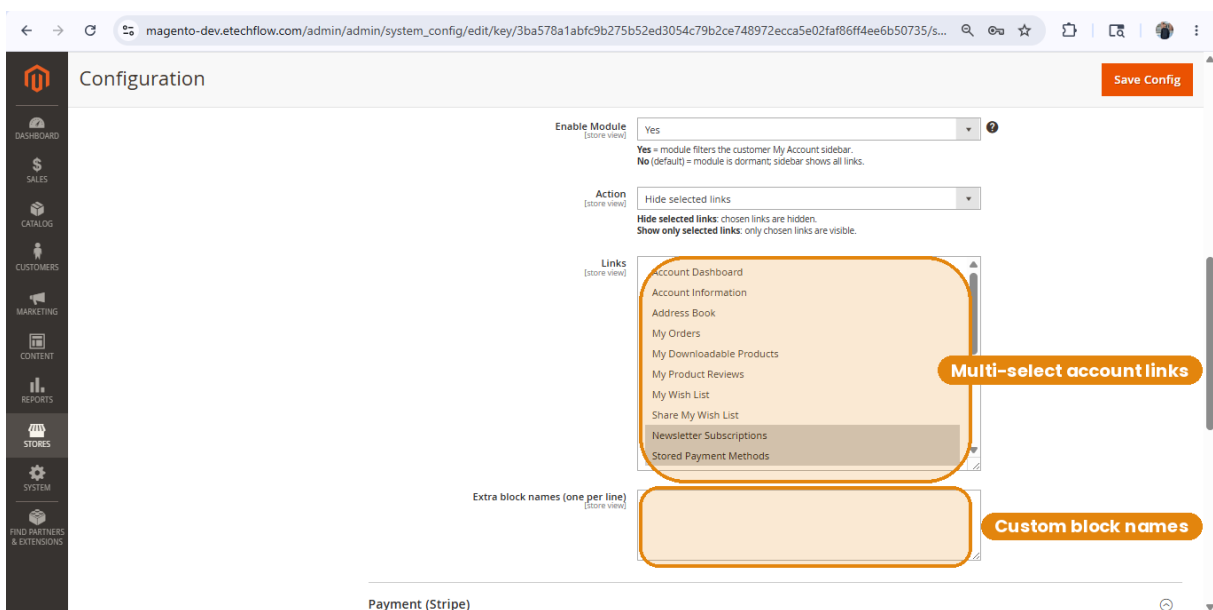


Figure 10 — The full Links multi-select showing every selectable account link, plus the optional "Extra block names (one per line)" field below for targeting custom sidebar blocks by name.

[ Extra block names (one per line) ] Optional. Add the layout block names of any custom or third-party sidebar links, one per line, so the module can hide or show them alongside the built-in links.

[ Save Config ] Saves the General Settings and applies the filter to the storefront My Account sidebar immediately.

### 3. Storefront Result

Once Enable Module is Yes and you have saved your selections, the changes appear on the customer-facing My Account page (Luma storefront). The examples below show how the sidebar changes depending on which links you hide.

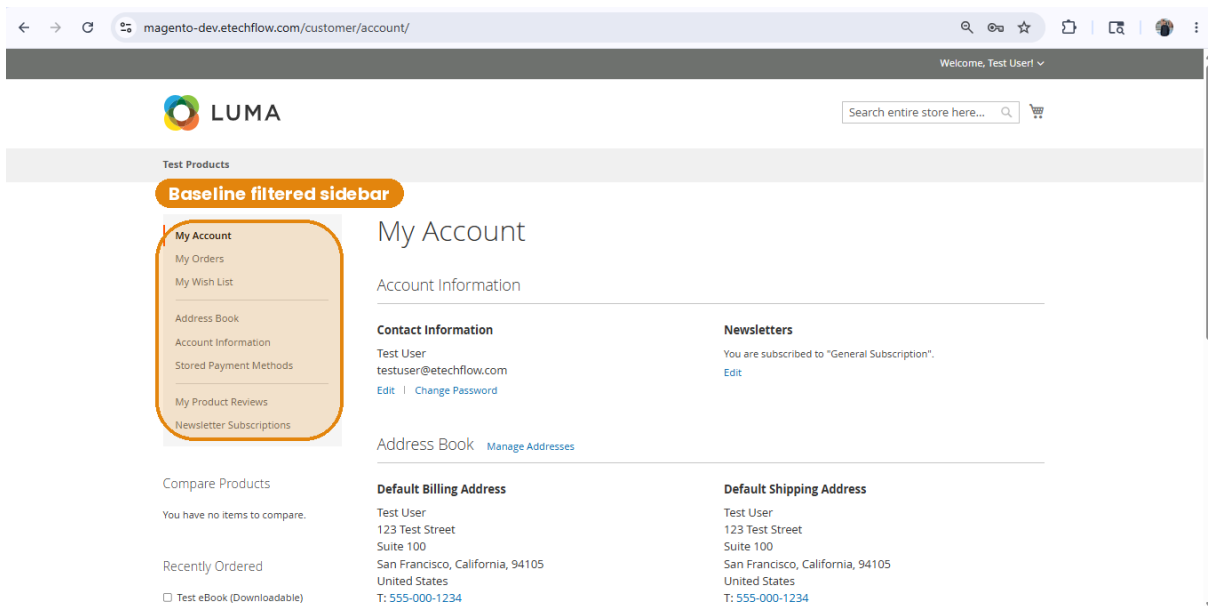


Figure 11 — A My Account sidebar with My Orders and My Wish List present, plus Address Book, Account Information, Stored Payment Methods, My Product Reviews, and Newsletter Subscriptions — a baseline filtered view.

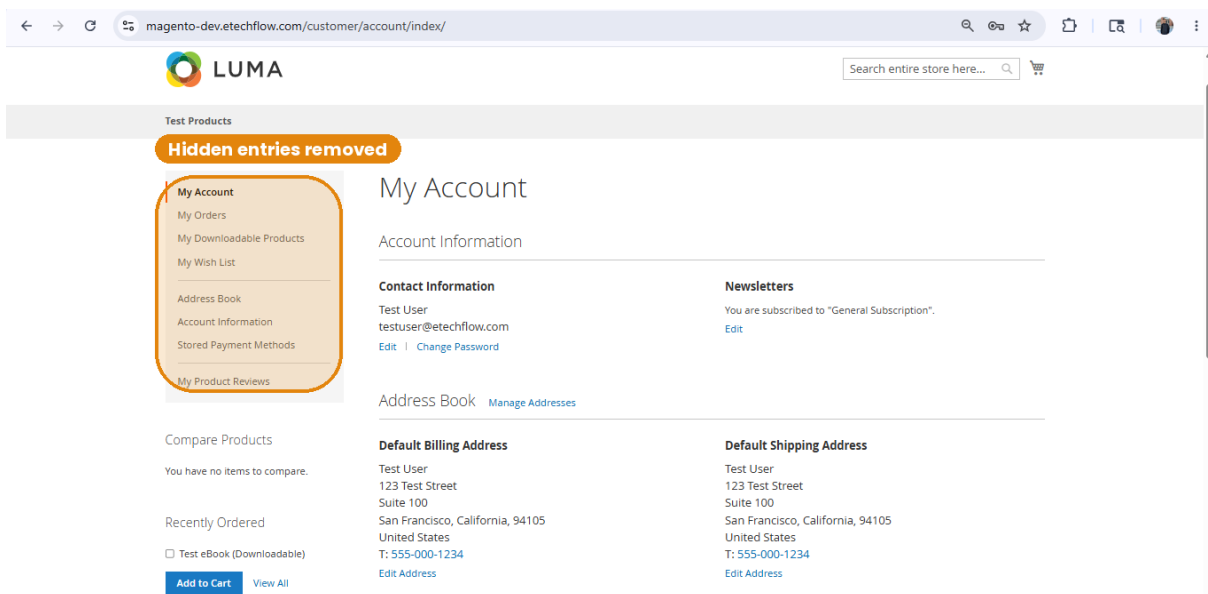


Figure 12 — Result of hiding My Wish List and Newsletter Subscriptions: the sidebar keeps My Orders, My Downloadable Products, Address Book, Account Information, Stored Payment Methods, and My Product Reviews, but the hidden entries are gone.

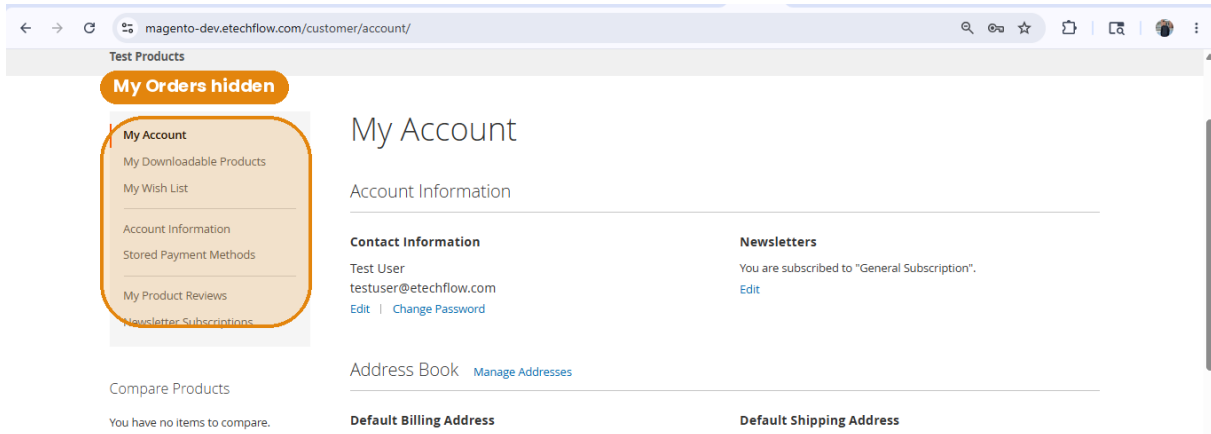


Figure 13 — Result of hiding My Orders: the sidebar now starts with My Account, My Downloadable Products, and My Wish List — no My Orders link is shown.

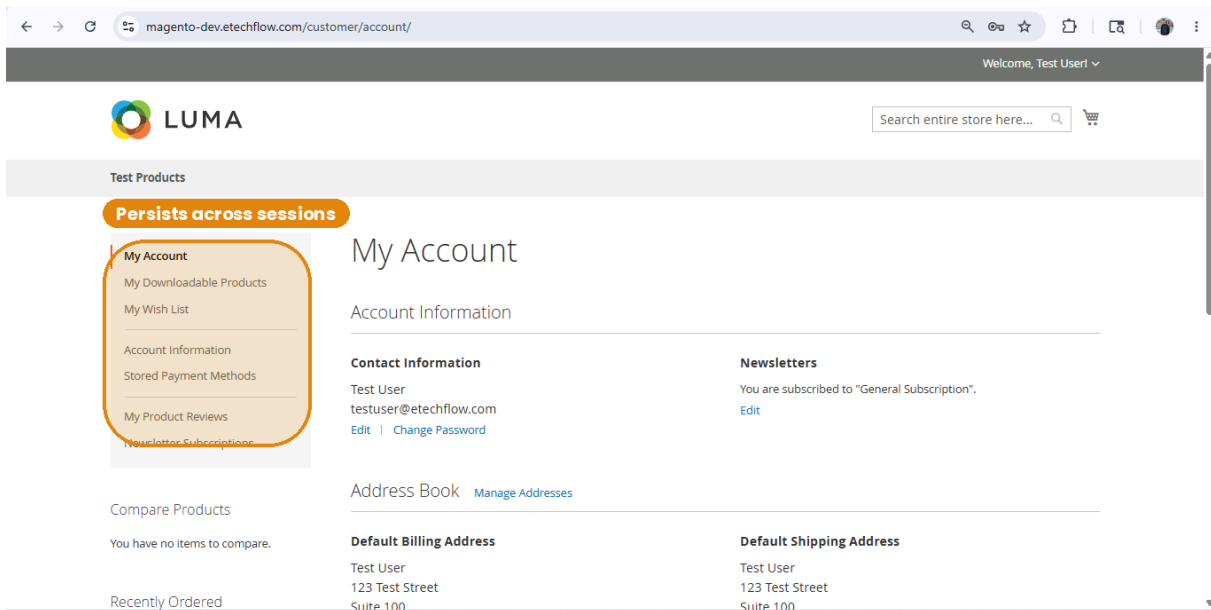


Figure 14 — Another filtered My Account page (Welcome, Test User) with My Orders hidden — confirming the selected link stays removed across sessions.
